Structured Administrative Setup for Foreign Founders in Oman

Entering a new country to establish a business is not simply a matter of registration.

For many foreign founders, the early administrative phase can feel fragmented — with legal structures, residency procedures, documentation, government fees, and sequencing of steps often appearing unclear from the outside.



This engagement is designed for foreign founders who want to enter Oman through a more structured and coordinated administrative path from the beginning.

Who This Is For

This engagement may be suitable for founders who:

- want smoother coordination between the different parts of the setup process
- value a more organized entry into the Omani market



Who This Is Not For

This engagement is generally not suitable for people who:

- expect instant company formation without proper documentation
- are looking for shortcuts or regulatory workarounds
- want guaranteed timelines from government authorities
- expect full legal, tax, or accounting services within this engagement



What This Engagement Focuses On

This process helps coordinate the key administrative elements required for establishing an initial legal presence in Oman.

Typical areas covered may include:

- company registration coordination
- clarification of legal structure options
- sequencing of registration and residency procedures
- guidance around investor residency requirements
- clarification of government fees and expected costs



- coordination with licensed local service providers involved in the setup
- preparation for the early stages of corporate bank account readiness
- support during the initial administrative phase of entering the market

The exact scope may vary depending on the business activity, ownership structure, and the founder's circumstances.



What This Engagement Does Not Include

Unless clearly agreed otherwise, this engagement does not include:

- legal representation
- tax structuring or accounting services
- business strategy advisory
- brand development or marketing services
- full operational setup of the business
- guaranteed timelines for government processing
- guaranteed approval of licenses, registrations, or visas

This is a structured administrative guidance and coordination engagement.

How the Process Works

- **01 – Strategic Consultation**
A short consultation to understand the founder's background, intended activity, and objectives for entering Oman.
- **02 – Scope Definition**
Clarifying whether the engagement is a good fit and defining the advisory and coordination scope.
- **03 – Setup Structuring**
Reviewing the appropriate legal structure and sequencing the administrative steps involved.



- **04 – Administrative Coordination**
Providing structured guidance and coordinating with licensed local service providers through the agreed process.
- **05 – Initial Setup Completion**
Supporting the founder until the agreed early administrative milestones have been completed.



Duration

The duration depends on the scope and complexity of the case, the readiness of the required documentation, and government processing timelines.

Most engagements are typically structured over approximately 2 to 4 weeks.



Investment

Engagements typically start from **1300 OMR**, depending on the scope, complexity, and coordination required.

Government fees — such as commercial registration and investor residency fees — are included.

A clear fee is confirmed before the engagement begins.



Strategic Consultation

All engagements begin with a short strategic consultation to understand the founder's situation and determine whether this process would be valuable.
